\*This week in Math the students learned to find the product of a whole number and a mixed number using the distributive property, solve multiplicative comparison word problems, and solve word problems with line plots. We also reviewed for our End of Module

Assessment. Next week the students will learn how to make equivalent fractions and decimals for tenths and hundredths, to add decimals, and to place decimals on a number line.

-End of Module 5 Assessment will be on Monday. The topics covered will be fractions and mixed numbers (add, subtract, compare, multiply a whole number and a fraction/mixed number, line plots & word problems).

\*What a great week in ELA. We presented our nonfiction stories, which were really good. We completed our research and created a slideshow with the information. The students really had a great time doing this. The slideshows they created were wonderful. These will also be presented. We will be moving to write literary essays next.

\*We are once again participating in the Captains Reading Program. We will be starting that as soon as we come back from Spring Break. This will be done along with the reading log. Students must complete and turn in a correct reading log each Friday to get credit and move on to the next base. Read 5 days for 20 minutes out of the 7 day week turn it in on Friday and they will get credit. Read only 4 days and they do not get credit towards the next base. If your child has been completing the reading log correctly then you are all set. The Madison Avenue Captains game is on May 31st.

\*This week in Science we did lessons on the relationship of stride in height in humans and in dinosaurs.

\*In Social Studies we finished up the Tecumseh unit and will be moving to early travel methods.
