*This week in Math the students learned how to create and solve word problems with line plots, add mixed numbers and a fraction, add mixed numbers, subtract a fraction from a mixed number, subtract a mixed number from a mixed number, and to represent the multiplication of n times a/b as $(n \times a)/b$ using the associative property. Next week we will finish Module 5 (fractions). The End of Module Assessment will be most likely be on Monday, 3/18.
