*This week in Math the students learned specific characteristics of two-dimensional shapes- triangles (scalene, isosceles, equilateral, right, obtuse, and acute) and quadrilaterals (trapezoid, parallelogram, rhombus, rectangle, square) and reviewed three-dimensional figures (cube, rectangular prism, cylinder, and cone) and money.
