*This week in Math the students learned to read and write large numbers using the 3 forms- standard form (425), word form (four hundred twenty-five), and expanded form ($400 + 20 + 5$), and compare numbers, Next week the students will find 1, 10, and 100 thousand more or less than a given number, and start rounding with a vertical number line.

-The 10 question quiz on Friday is over the 16 daily problems that your child completes Monday-Thursday (Day 1, Day 2, Day 3, & Day 4). Your child should study those 16 questions every Thursday for the quiz.

-Reminder- all students should be on xtramath.org at least 4 days every week (Monday-Sunday).

*We have had a busy week. Everyone has been tested for a reading level, now we are going to get moving with our reading. I am looking forward to building reading levels. Grammar wasn't as good this week. There were quite a few that did not finish the packet. This surprised me because students had a large amount of time when they could work on this while I was testing students. Reading logs are doing ok. Remember read 5 out of 7 days to get 5 points.

*This week in Science we did an experiment with tootsie pops focusing on the Scientific Method. We also started learning about erosion and deposition, and did an activity called 'At the Beach'.

*Social Studies we discovered United States Regions as well as Ohio Regions and also learned about some landforms. We also started watching Newsdepth today. This is a news show geared toward students. We will watch this each week and then write about some of what we saw.
