

Hello!

*This week in math the students continued to round a multi-digit number to any given place and used rounding in real world applications. The students had to decide when rounding which place value gave the most accurate answer. The students also rotated through centers to review for their Mid-Module Assessment on Lessons 1-10 and reviewed addition and drawing tape diagrams (bar models). Next week we will add and subtract using the standard algorithm and use tape diagrams to solve multi-step word problems.

-PLEASE continue to write a quick note or sign off if your child is struggling. Please have them complete as much as possible and then stop after 20 minutes. PLEASE no crying, fighting, etc. Send it back with a note and I will go over it in class.

-Your child should complete xtramath 4 days every week. Please make sure your child is doing this.

*We have had a fun week, with the homecoming spirit week and regular school activities. Grammar packets were better this week, almost everyone turned them in. Good job! Reading logs are doing well also. Remember your child has 7 days to read 5 times. We are continuing to read and develop characters. We have started doing some writing for story writing. This will take some time and will continue with this, but I am looking forward to the final product.

*This week in science we did an experiment called Ice Breakers. The students compared a model rock made from a water balloon and dough and a real rock. The students completed a study guide for weathering, erosion, and deposition. There will be a quiz on Tuesday.

*In Social Studies we have finished up with the US Constitution. We are now moving to timelines. Students will be creating a timeline of their life, which is always fun for them.
