*This week in Math most of the students took their MAP test. Even though it was hot, they worked really hard. I was very proud of them. (This is just a benchmark score for them to improve throughout the year.) We also went over our first quiz and I taught them how to do test corrections. Next week the students will learn how to read and write large numbers using the 3 forms, standard form (425), word form (four hundred twenty-five), and expanded form ($400 + 20 + 5$), compare numbers, and find 1, 10, and 100 thousand more or less than a given number.

*Well we have had quite a week, with the holiday and heat, your children are real troopers. We are continuing to intensely grow our reading ideas, it is fun. The read aloud book we are reading really allows for this with the vocabulary that the author chooses to use. We talk about this while sitting on the carpet. Students are doing a good job with the reading log and grammar packets. Keep up the good work. This is assigned every week.

-Next week I will have each student read to me to get a level for their reading. Most should be at or above where they left off at the end of 3rd grade.

-We also MAP tested to get a fall score.

*This week in Science we continued learning about the Scientific Method. Next week we will do an experiment with tootsie pops focusing on the Scientific Method and start learning about erosion.

*In Social Studies we are continuing with directions and moving to regions of the United States and the importance of these regions.
