April 28, 2015 Meeting

The following **Finance/Audit** recommendations were approved:

- ❖ Financial reports for all funds, Budget Modification report, Fund to Fund Transfers and the Check Payment Register report for March 2015.
- ❖ Approval of an agreement with Georgann Richardson to provide tutoring services to Hershey Montessori students for the 2014-15 school year at a cost of \$3,880. Agreement will be paid with Hershey Montessori's Auxiliary Services funds.
- ❖ Approval of a General Contract for Services with Brailled On Belvedere, LLC for educational purposes of a handicapped student from Riverside Local Schools beginning March 16, 2015 through the end of the 2014-2015 school year.
- ❖ Approval of a General Contract for Services with Brailled On Belvedere, LLC for educational purposes of handicapped students from Riverside Local Schools beginning June 4, 2015 through August 2015.

The following **Curriculum & Programming** recommendations were approved:

- ❖ Approval of the 2015 Riverside High School Volleyball Camp, All-American Volleyball camp, for participants in grades 9-12, at a cost of \$130 per participant, to be held July 27-29, 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. at Riverside High School/Field House. There will be no cost to the Board of Education.
- ❖ Approval of the 2015 Riverside High School Volleyball Camp for participants in grades 6-8, at a cost of \$50 per participant, to be held July 27-30, 4:00-6:00 p.m. at Riverside High School/Field House. There will be no cost to the Board of Education.
- ❖ Approval of the 2015 Riverside High School Varsity Team Volleyball Camp to be held at Sports Express Volleyball Center, July 20-22, at a cost of \$160 per participant. There will be no cost to the Board of Education.
- ❖ Approval of the 2015 Riverside Youth Softball Camp for participants entering grades 1st – 8th. The camp will be held at Riverside High School and will run June 8th through June 10th. The cost of camp will be \$75 for hitting, fielding and base running. There will be no cost to the Board of Education.
- ❖ Approval of the 2015 Riverside High School Football Camp for children entering grades 1-5 to be held at RHS. The camp will be Monday, June 8th through Thursday, June 11th from 9:00am-11:00am. The coaches will be the Riverside Coaches. The camp will cost each child \$40. A discount will be given to families with more than one child attending the camp. If a family has two children, the total cost would be \$70, and if the family has three or more children, the total cost would be \$90. There will be no cost to the Board of Education.
- ❖ Approval of the 2015 Riverside High School Football Camp for children entering grades 6-8 to be held at RHS. The camp will be Monday, June 8th through Thursday, June 11th from 12:00pm-3:00pm. The coaches will be the Riverside Coaches. The camp will cost each child \$50. A discount will be given to families with more than one child attending the camp. If a family has two children, the total cost would be \$80, and if the family has three or more children, the total cost would be \$110. There will be no cost to the Board of Education.

The following **Buildings & Grounds/Operations** recommendation was approved:

- ❖ Approval of an access control project for Madison Avenue, Leroy, Melridge and Hadden Elementary Schools funded by the Latchkey Fund 020 at a cost of \$23,690.78 with DataServ. This project will improve and establish the key fob program for the Latchkey program at these locations.
