#### **Coat and Boot Donation**

With Winter upon us and the holidays right around the corner, if you happen to have a gently used coat or pair of boots that your child has outgrown, you may bring them to the school. We have some who do not have winter coats or boots. We ask that they are clean and in good condition (free of tears or holes and zippers or fasteners that work) You may bring them into the school office. As a reminder, we go outside for recess provided the windchill is above 20 degrees. Students who come to school in shorts or

without a coat will not be permitted to go outside during the winter months.

## **MAP Testing**

We will be MAP testing beginning next week. Students will take the assessment in the computer lab for K-2 and on the classroom ChromeBooks. Riverside Schools utilize MAP testing to monitoring student growth and progress three times per year in the areas of reading and math. Teachers use these data points to provide intervention and enrichment in their classroom instruction.



#### **Holiday Sing-along**

Prior to the classroom parties on Thursday, December 20, the students will have a sing-along led by Miss Kish. It will begin around 2:15. This will allow our

homeroom parents to get into the classrooms and get set up for the parties which will begin at 2:45. This is just a way to spread some holiday cheer and free up the classrooms for our parent volunteers.

## **Spelling Bee**

The District-wide Elementary School Spelling Bee will be held on Thursday, January 10 at 4:15. This event will be at Buckeye Elementary School, located at 175 Buckeye Drive in Painesville Township. The contest will be for classroom winners and alternates from grades 4 and 5 from each elementary building. Each classroom champion and alternate will be sent home the official word list prior to break to study the words for this written test. Grade level winners or alternates will then compete in the District level Spelling Bee for grades 4-8 on Thursday, January 17 in the Riverside Lecture Room.
