transportation for these students to their selected schools; and

WHEREAS the following factors as identified in Revised Code 3327.01 have been considered: (1) the number of pupils to be transported; and (2) the cost of providing transportation in terms of equipment, maintenance, personnel, and administration to:

All Saints of St. John Vianney, Andrews-Osborne Academy, Cornerstone Christian Academy, Hershey Montessc School, Lake Catholic High School, St. Mary's School–Chardon, and Willo-Hill Christian School.

WHEREAS the option of offering payment in lieu of transportation is provided in Revised Code. Therefore, Be I RESOLVED that the Riverside Local Board of Education hereby approves the declaration of impractical to transport for the identified students, and offering them payment in lieu of transportation.
