ISSUE 1

On The Ballot TUES., MAY 2

The District has a 4.9-mill continuous operating levy on the Tuesday, May 2 ballot.

If ISSUE 1 is approved by voters, the District will restore bus service, elementary-level programs and reduce fees for pay-to-participate starting with the 2017-2018

school year. Funds would also be used for general operations throughout the District.

If approved, **busing would be restored for all grades** – kindergarten through 12th grade – for students who live outside of a half-mile drive of his or her school. **Pay-to-participate fees will decrease** to \$200 for high school sports and \$150 for



7th and 8th grade sports.

The fee for cheerleading (grades 7-12) and marching band will also be \$150. **The District will also restore elementary-level programs** which may include arts, health and wellness and technology.

Currently, the District only buses students grades K-5

who live more than one mile from their school and grades 6-8 who live more than two miles from their school. There is no busing for students in grades 9-12.

If approved, the levy would cost tax payers \$14.29 per month per \$100,000 valuation. For a list of frequently asked questions regarding ISSUE 1, visit www.riversidelocalschools.com.
