Dear first grade families,



Phonics Focus this week is on multi-syllable words. Students may think these words are harder just because they are longer. We are working on braking them down into each syllable then putting them together. The students have been doing a wonderful job with this! This will also help them to remember to chunk words into syllables when they come to an unknown word when reading.







What We're Learning

Reading: I am completing the assessment of sight words lists 5 and 6. We will be focusing with words on lists 7 and 8. Students should practice reading these words: good, sentence, man, think, say, great, where, help, through, much, before, line, right, too, mean, old, any, same, tell, boy, follow, came, want, show, also, around, form, three, small, set, put, end, does, another, well, large, must, big, even, such. **We have started a new reading focus with reading workshop by Lucy Calkins. You will hear more about this for writing soon! In reading we will be starting on a non-fiction unit. Please encourage your child to be reading non-fiction books at home.

Grammar: We are still working on verbs and talking about adjectives. I will be asking you to do another activity with sending in some things from home in a lunch bag (similar to our Thankful bags). This will help us with interactive writing, verbs, and adjectives! I will be sending home more information about this next week!

Phonics/Word Study: Next week we will continue with multi-syllable words. The students are doing great with this concept. However, next week's words will be a little more difficult (adding more phonics features with the 2 syllables. Please make sure that your child is working on their words at home.

Math- We just started a unit on place-value. Right now we are working on numbers to 40. Please make sure your child knows about the tens place and ones place.

S.S- We will be learning about different President's in our country's history.

Science- We will be doing experiments as we focus on motion and how things move!
