Classroom News




Dear first grade families,

What We're Learning

Reading: Please keep working on Fry Words lists 1 and 2. List 1: the, and, to, is, that, he, for, are, with, they, of, in, you, it, was, on, as, his, I. List 2: at, this, from, one, by, but, what, were, when, can, be, have, or, had, word, not, all, we, your, and said. We will be having a test over the first two lists of words at the end of the week. Your child only needs to read these words by sight (they don't need to spell them). For comprehension we are starting to learn about story elements: Who are the characters? What is the setting? What are the main events in the story? We are also really working on fluency in reading (reading smoothly). Reading poems is very helpful with this! In language we are really focusing on ending our sentences with a period for a statement and a question mark for a question.

Phonics/Word Study: This week is a review week in Word Study. We will be practicing writing sentences (both telling and asking) with our digraph words. Please work on simple dictations at home.

Foundations- In Foundations we are starting a new unit. We are focusing on the bonus letter rule (the FLOSS rule). Basically, if a one syllable word that has a short vowel ends in f, l, s, then we double that letter at the end. Ex: hill, miss, puff, bell, stiff, etc. You will get more information about this (don't worry if you are confused with our phonics rules).

Math: We are doing a lot of subtracting in our math unit. We are also doing subtraction story problems. Please have your child work on what number is one less than a given number. We are going to be working on fact families (for a LONG time this year). Basically a fact family is when you have 3 numbers (4, 5, 9) and you use them in 2 addition and 2 subtraction facts. For Example: $4+5=9$, $5+4=9$, $9-4=5$, $9-5=4$
