### What We're Learning

Reading: We are continuing to work on our Daily 5. We have now been working on Read to Self and Work on Writing. For Work on Writing students will be journal writing, writing lists, and writing the room. Next week I will introduce Listening to Reading (reading on the computers) and word work (working with our Word Study words). I have been meeting with small reading groups to work on more concepts for their individual reading needs. Books will be coming home next week for you to read at home. (If I ever send home a paper book, just keep it at home. If I send home an actual book, please send it back after reading because it belongs to me).

Phonics/Word Study: We have been working on reading and writing short vowel words (CVC words). Please make sure your child knows all of the short vowel sounds. Next week you will get a list of words that we will be working on for word study. These words follow the same CVC pattern we have been working on in class. We are trying something new this year. Instead of sending home a homework packet for you to work on the words. We will send home a list of ideas of how you can practice the words. However your child wants to study them is fine. They will have a test over the words on the last day of each week.

Math: We are still working on number bonds and

solving story problems with numbers to 10. The students are getting so much better with this. We do not send home

weekly math packets for homework because each aviatroplem set will help your child with the homework.

Science/Social Studies: I am amazed by how interested this class is in Science and Social Studies! Today was Constitution Day and the discussion we had and the questions they asked were unbelievable! In Social Studies we have also been learning about John Chapman (Johnny Appleseed). In Science we started our study of Energy. We are now learning about how we get energy from the sun!
